

FISHERY RULES.

1. Fly fishing ONLY (No other method).
2. Wet fly, nymph and dry fly allowed.
3. Maximum hook size – 10 Long Shank.
4. One hook per fly, no tandems, doubles or trebles.
5. Maximum 3 flies per leader.
6. No more than two trout can be killed per member per week until the last day of August. After this date four trout may be killed per week.
7. No trout under 23cms to be killed.
8. Trout fishing on all waters from 3 March to 30 September.
9. Grayling fishing allowed from 1 October to the last day of February from the conflux of the River Dee with the River Ceiriog upstream to Pont y Blew (Forge Bridge) only. No Grayling are to be killed.
10. Wading allowed.
11. Barbless or de-barbed hooks to be used at all times.
12. Membership cards must be carried at all times whilst on the river and should be produced on request by the keeper or fellow members. Anglers without a membership card should leave the river forthwith.
13. A vehicle identification card must be clearly displayed in the member's vehicle when parked by the river.
14. Guest tickets may be used as per current rules.
15. Members must post their catch returns promptly to the clubs on line forum. Catch returns should be logged against the appropriate beat.
16. Members will be advised from time to time of the relevant numbers to be used to report incidents on the river including poaching etc.
17. Fishing is for Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout and Grayling. If the appropriate licence is held then Sea Trout may be fished for as long as rules 1 to 5 are adhered to.
18. No fishing for Salmon is allowed.

19. Pollution – Any members observing signs of obvious pollution in the waterway is earnestly requested to advise the appropriate authority.
20. Cars should be parked with care to avoid causing obstruction to riparian owners and their employees.
21. Care should be taken to keep river banks free from litter and nylon waste. All waste should be removed at the end of your day on the river.
22. Any member causing damage will be held personally responsible for same.
23. Where fishing is adjacent to a public footpath, care should be taken and allowed for when casting.
24. Courtesy on the river – Members should not fish within 50 meters upstream or downstream of any other member already fishing, except by invitation. This also applies to guests.
